Sure we sometimes get into mischief and yes we like to run around, but hey we’re still kids and we are here to make you smile!



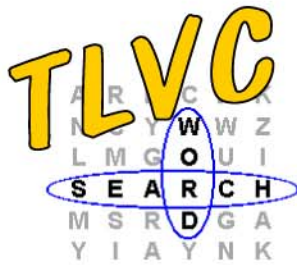
The Ladies Auxiliary Tea
